Our plans and vision:

We aim to create a spiritually nourishing space, rooted in Quaker values and open to all. We both have young children and are keen to ensure it is suitable for all ages. Our hope is to serve the wider Hoddesdon community by offering a place of welcome, connection, reflection, and learning.

Worship will be grounded in silence but full of life—guided at times by readings, queries, creativity, music. The aim is to create a rhythm that is both deepening for long-time Friends and accessible to newcomers, with clear explanations and warm hospitality. We hope to nurture a culture in which ministry arises naturally and is shared often, as a sign of a spiritually healthy group.

Community and friendship will be central. Shared meals will be part of each gathering, helping us build relationships across generations. We'll embrace the meeting house and eco garden not just as a venue, but as part of our spiritual expression—gardening together, caring for nature, and perhaps worshipping outdoors when possible.
